

Camps and travel routes around Cape Dorset, Nunavut



The base map was created from the National Topographic Service (NTS) map sheets 35N and 36C, D, 1:250 000 scale, UTM zones 17 & 18 (ocean, rivers, shorelines, place names, and map limits), NAD1983. Please note that place names (spelling and location) are shown as indicated on the NTS map sheets (because the official Inuktitut versions are not yet available). Maps were reprojected to Lambert Conformal Conic, NAD1997, to show all results together (due to different UTM zones). Sea ice features are shown as drawn by interview participants (Abiaq Alusauq, Enuk Ebfioruk, Ashvak Etkuk, Mathewus Joanne, Sany Kelly, Mangak Kallipalik, Eliyah Mangak, Jimmy Manning, Ootqak Mikigak, Adami Nuna, Iqroq Nungasutuk, Ooputalik Ootulik, Aida Puri, Ebfioruk Petulaisuk, Qisqeya Petulaisuk, Ningsoosak Peter, Paulusik Pootopok, Mikisik Salla, Kanyuk Sofomene, Simpaq Sovega, and Quivianqulqap Tapungak), local sea ice experts, in May and November 2004 and January 2005.
