The Climate Change Preparedness in the North program has received \$21.4 --- 111.

The Climate Change Preparedness in the North program has received \$21.4 million from 2016 to 2021 and \$24.4 million from 2017 to 2022 in funding for climate change adaptation projects. The program's primary objective is to provide support to northern communities and organizations & territorial and regional governments to help them adapt to climate change impacts.

AREAS OF FOCUS:

- Northern regions (Yukon, Northwest Territories, Nunavut, Nunatsiavut, and Nunavik (Including Eeyou Istchee and Nunatukavut communities)
- Climate change adaptation projects which increase Indigenous and northern communities <u>adaptability</u>, <u>resilience</u> and <u>growth</u>
- Priority is given to projects that demonstrate strong Indigenous and/or community leadership, engagement, or partnerships.
