# **Objectives**

- Identify the factors contributing to research fatigue and saturation in Nunavut;
- Design new ways to track and improve the relevance and benefits of research to Nunavummiut;
- Develop new reporting and communication tools to improve the accessibility of research results for community members, organizations, and decision-makers;
- Develop recommendations for the respectful use of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit in all research processes; and,
- Create training and mentorship resources to enhance research capacity in Nunavut.

## Who can complete the survey?

- **Individually** (i.e. one person designated on behalf of the group, and responding based on their own experience); or,
- **As a group** (i.e. one person responding on behalf of the group, based on group discussion of questions).
